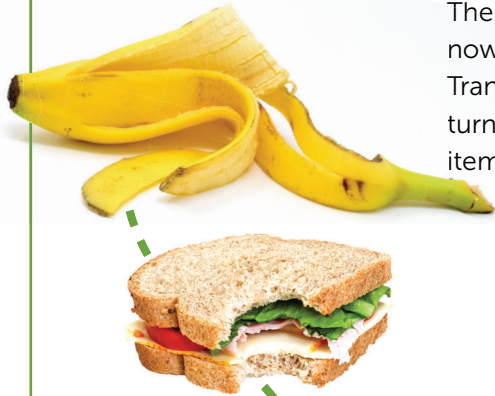


FOOD SCRAP RECYCLING IN WESTPORT



The Town of Westport has launched a food scrap recycling program! Residents can now bring ALL food scraps to the Food Scrap Drop-Off Area at the Westport Transfer Station. The material is then brought to a commercial compost facility and turned into soil! All food scraps are accepted (more than just backyard composting items) including:

- FRUITS
- VEGETABLES
- MEAT & FISH
- DAIRY
- BREAD
- RICE
- PASTA
- RAW & COOKED FOOD
- CUT FLOWERS
- COFFEE GROUNDS & FILTERS
- PAPER TEA BAGS
- NAPKINS & PAPER TOWELS
- WAX PAPER

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1

COLLECT food scraps & paper products in a countertop pail using compostable bags

2

STORE bags of food scraps in a storage and transportation bin

3

BRING your storage and transportation bin to the Transfer Station and empty into the larger bins at the Food Scrap Drop-Off Area



WHAT DO I NEED TO START?

Although they are not required, food scrap recycling "starter kits" make it easy. Kits are \$25/kit (discounts available for income-eligible) and include:

- Countertop pail
- Storage and transportation bin
- Roll of 25 compostable bags
